HB 1192 -- DRIVERLESS-CAPABLE COMMERCIAL VEHICLES

SPONSOR: Rowland

This bill allows businesses that employ more than 50 people to use driverless vehicles. The vehicles must be of minimal risk if it malfunctions, be compliant with Missouri's vehicle laws and regulations, and adhere to federal vehicle safety standards. If a business has over 50 employees, that business must not convert more than one-sixteenth of its vehicles to driverless vehicles. If a business has over 50 employees and converts more than one-sixteenth of its vehicles to driverless, that business will either be subject to tax liability or fees.
