HCR 33 -- CHEMICAL TESTING

SPONSOR: Windham

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Urban Issues by a vote of 6 to 0.

This resolution urges the United States Army to explain, in town hall sessions, chemical testing in the St. Louis region in the 1950s and 1960s and for the Environmental Protection Agency and the United States Department of Health and Human Services to conduct a study to track the health effects on those populations exposed.

This bill is similar to HCR 14 (2017).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the residents in the areas affected by the testing deserve to have their questions answered.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Windham.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
