

HJR 25 -- INITIATIVES AND REFERENDUMS

SPONSOR: Deaton

Upon voter approval, this proposed Constitutional amendment would require that any initiative petition proposing an amendment to the Constitution will take effect at the end of 30 days after the election when approved by at least a two-thirds majority of the votes cast. However, for any amendment that was approved prior to December 3, 2020, an initiative petition to repeal such amendment, without any additional modifications or new language, will take effect when approved by majority of the votes cast.

The resolution would also modify the signature requirement for placing an amendment on the ballot by mandating that the two-thirds of requisite voters requirement be satisfied in each of the 163 legislative districts for members of the Missouri House of Representatives.
