HJR 31 -- TERM LIMITS

SPONSOR: Plocher

Upon voter approval, this proposed Constitutional amendment imposes a two-term limit on the offices of Governor and all statewide elected officials. The exception for service less than two years to an office to which another individual was elected is maintained.

The amendment also allows an individual to be elected to 16 years of service in the General Assembly with any combination of terms of two or four years allowed between service in the House of Representatives and Senate.

This bill is the same as SJR 14 (2019).
