SB 368 -- DEALER LICENSE PLATES

SPONSOR: Hough (Shawan)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 12 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 8 to 0.

This bill allows use of specified motor vehicle dealer license plates on cars used by customers while their vehicles are being serviced or repaired by the motor vehicle dealer.

This bill is the same as HB 926 (2019).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that customers typically expect this service which is offered by most out of state dealerships. The bill will help Missouri businesses compete.

Testifying for the bill were Senator Hough; and the Missouri Automobile Dealers Association.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
