SPONSOR: Hough (Trent)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Tourism by a vote of 8 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 8 to 0.

This resolution designates November as "National American History and Founders Month" to urge public officials at all levels, educators, and all the people of Missouri to observe the month with appropriate programs, ceremonies, and activities, and reaffirm their devotion to the principles of freedom and the common history and heritage shared by all Americans.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill will encourage greater recognition of history and founding of the United States of America. November is a month with numerous historical designation and holidays, so this is befitting.
