1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1600, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by
2 inserting after said section and line the following:

4 "115.280. 1. Any defendant who is confined in a jail and is otherwise entitled to vote, shall
5 be allowed the opportunity to vote absentee in any election in which they are eligible to vote. For
6 purposes of this section, the defendant's address shall be their residential address immediately prior
7 to confinement.

8 2. Jails that house defendants who are eligible to vote shall provide applications for absentee
9 ballots and assist any eligible defendant in mailing the application to the correct local election
10 authority. The jail shall be responsible for the costs of mailing the application.

11 3. Local election authorities that receive applications from defendants confined in a jail shall
12 verify the defendant's eligibility to vote in the same manner as other applications to vote absentee
13 are verified and shall mail the appropriate ballot, including a postage-paid return envelope, to the
14 defendant.

15 4. Upon receipt of a ballot, the defendant shall be allowed to exercise his or her right to
16 vote. The jail shall provide a notary for the ballot, if required, and mail the ballot back to the local
17 election authority before the deadline."; and

19 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
20 accordingly.
