1 AMEND Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 594, Page 1,  
2 Section A, Line 2, by inserting after said section and line the following:

3  
4 "44.080. 1. Each political subdivision of this state shall establish a local organization for  
5 disaster planning in accordance with the state emergency operations plan and program. The  
6 executive officer of the political subdivision shall appoint a coordinator who shall have direct  
7 responsibility for the organization, administration and operation of the local emergency management  
8 operations, subject to the direction and control of the executive officer or governing body. Each  
9 local organization for emergency management shall be responsible for the performance of  
10 emergency management functions within the territorial limits of its political subdivision, and may  
11 conduct these functions outside of the territorial limits as may be required pursuant to the provisions  
12 of this law.

13 2. In carrying out the provisions of this law, each political subdivision may:

14 (1) Appropriate and expend funds, make contracts, obtain and distribute equipment,  
15 materials, and supplies for emergency management purposes; provide for the health and safety of  
16 persons; the safety of property; and direct and coordinate the development of disaster plans and  
17 programs in accordance with the policies and plans of the federal and state governments; and

18 (2) Appoint, provide, or remove rescue teams, auxiliary fire and police personnel and other  
19 emergency operations teams, units or personnel who may serve without compensation.

20 3. No state of emergency declared by a county executive shall be imposed or continue for  
21 more than fifteen days without a sixty percent majority vote of the county governing body  
22 approving and setting the number of days beyond the fifteen days."; and

24 Further amend said bill, Page 10, Section 135.710, Line 137, by inserting after said section and line  
25 the following:

27 "Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to protect the safety of the community  
28 and to reduce the loss of lives in an emergency situation, the repeal and reenactment of section  
29 44.080 of this act is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare,  
30 peace, and safety, and is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the  
31 constitution, and the repeal and reenactment of section 44.080 of this act shall be in full force and  
32 effect upon its passage and approval."; and

34 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
35 accordingly.
