3	"550.010. Whenever any person shall be convicted of any
4	crime or misdemeanor he shall be adjudged to pay the costs, and
5	no costs incurred on his part, except fees for the cost of
6	incarceration, including a reasonable sum to cover occupancy
7	costs, shall be paid by the state or county. Any costs that are
8	the responsibility of the defendant to pay may be collected as
9	court costs and disbursed to the state or county under the
10	provisions of sections 488.010 to 488.020.
11	550.030. When the defendant is sentenced to imprisonment in
12	the county jail, or to pay a fine, or both, and is unable to pay
13	the costs, the county in which the indictment was found or
14	information filed shall pay the costs, except such as were
15	incurred on the part of the defendant. Any costs that are the
16	responsibility of the defendant to pay may be collected as court
17	costs and disbursed to the county under the provisions of
18	sections 488.010 to 488.020."; and
