1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute No. 2 for Senate Committee Substitute  
2 for Senate Bill No. 523, Page 34, Section 191.255, Line 5, by inserting after said section and line the  
3 following:

5 "191.1800. 1. Any publicly-funded transportation system may require passengers to wear a  
6 face mask or covering that covers both the nose and mouth.

7 2. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:

8 (1) "Publicly-funded transportation system", the property, equipment, rights-of-way, or  
9 buildings, either publicly or privately owned and operated, of an entity that receives public funds  
10 and holds itself out to the general public for the transportation of persons. This includes portions of  
11 a public transportation system provided through a contract with a private entity but excludes any  
12 corporation that provides intercity passenger train service on railroads throughout the United States  
13 or any private partnership in which the corporation engages; and

14 (2) "Face mask or covering", material worn to cover an individual's nose and mouth,  
15 including, but not limited to, a non-medical mask, scarf, handkerchief, and bandana.

16 3. The provisions of this section shall not apply to children two years of age or under or to  
17 passengers who have mental or physical health conditions that preclude such passengers from  
18 wearing face masks or coverings."; and

20 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
21 accordingly.
