Any action filed in violation of this section shall be dismissed. 10 2. A pandemic declared by the World Health Organization or a state of emergency declared by the governor in response to an outbreak of contagious illness shall be deemed an immediate 11 danger to the public health, safety, or welfare that requires emergency action under section 536.025. 12 13 3. The department of labor and industrial relations shall have authority to promulgate 14 emergency rules on housing-related issues that directly relate to mitigating the impact of the pandemic or emergency. The department shall follow the rulemaking procedures under section 15 16 536.025. 17 4. The department of labor and industrial relations shall post on its website relevant information on the emergency rules that is easily accessible to the public."; and 18 19 20 Further amend said bill, Page 131, Section D, Line 5, by inserting the following after all of said 21 section and line: 22 23 "Section E. Because immediate action is necessary to protect the health and welfare of the 24 residents of this state during the COVID-19 pandemic, the enactment of section 1 of this act is 25 deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and is hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and the 26 27 enactment of section 1 of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval."; 28 and 29 30 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references 31 accordingly.
