7	2. The Missouri accountability portal shall consist of an easy-to-search database of financial
8	transactions related to the purchase of goods and services and the distribution of funds for state
9	programs; all bonds issued by any public institution of higher education or political subdivision of
0	this state or its designated authority after August 28, 2013; all obligations issued or incurred
1	pursuant to section 99.820 by any political subdivision of this state or its designated authority; and
2	the revenue stream pledged to repay such bonds or obligations; and all debt incurred by any public
3	charter school.
4	3. The Missouri accountability portal shall be updated each state business day and
5	maintained as the primary source of information about the activity of Missouri's government.
6	4. Upon the conducting of a withholding or a release of funds, the governor shall submit a
7	report stating all amounts withheld from the state's operating budget for the current fiscal year, as
8 9	authorized by Article IV, Section 27 of the Missouri Constitution which shall be:
9 0	 Conspicuously posted on the accountability portal website; Searchable by the amounta withheld or released from each individual fund, and
1	(2) Searchable by the amounts withheld or released from each individual fund; and(3) Searchable by the total amount withheld or released from the operating budget.
2	5. Every political subdivision of the state, including public institutions of higher education
3	but excluding school districts, shall supply all information described in subsection 2 of this section
4	to the office of administration within seven days of issuing or incurring such corresponding bond or
5	obligation. For all such bonds or obligations issued or incurred prior to August 28, 2013, every such
6	political subdivision and public institution of higher education shall have ninety days to supply such
7	information to the office of administration.
8	6. Every school district and public charter school shall supply all information described in
9	subsection 2 of this section to the department of elementary and secondary education within seven
0	days of issuing such bond, or incurring such debt. The department of elementary and secondary
1	education shall have forty-eight hours to deliver such information to the office of administration.
2	For all such bonds issued or debt incurred prior to August 28, 2013, every school district and public
3	charter school shall have ninety days to supply such information to the department of elementary
4	and secondary education. The department of elementary and secondary education shall have forty-
5	eight hours to deliver such information to the office of administration.
