1 AMEND House Committee Substitute No. 2 for House Bill No. 1604, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by  
2 inserting immediately after said section and line the following:

4 "71.201. 1. For purposes of this section, the term "local governmental unit" shall mean any  
5 city, village, town, county, township, or the board of police established by section 84.020, or the  
6 board of police commissioners established by section 84.350.

7 2. (1) No local governmental unit shall require, as a condition of employment, that any  
8 currently employed or prospective law enforcement officer reside within any jurisdictional limit.

9 (2) If a local governmental unit has a residency rule or requirement for law enforcement  
10 officers that is in effect on or before August 28, 2020, the residency rule or requirement shall not  
11 apply and shall not be enforced.

12 3. A local governmental unit may impose a residency rule or requirement on law  
13 enforcement officers, but the rule or requirement shall be no more restrictive than requiring such  
14 personnel to reside within a one-hour response time.

15 4. The provisions of this section shall not apply to the Missouri state highway patrol."; and

17 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
18 accordingly.
