Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill No. 2120, Page 15, Section 701.200, Lines 17-18,

2 by striking "exceed five parts per billion of lead" and inserting
3 in lieu thereof the following: "exceed current standards for
4 parts per billion of lead established by the United States
5 Environmental Protection Agency".

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SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 2

Offered by Hegeman of Andrew

Amend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill No. 2120, Page 1, Section TITLE, Line 4,

2 by striking "safety of"; and further amend said bill and page,
3 Section A, line 4, by inserting after all of said line the
4 following:

5 "67.5122. Sections 67.5110 to 67.5122 shall expire on
6 January 1, [2021] 2025, except that for small wireless facilities
7 already permitted or collocated on authority poles prior to such
8 date, the rate set forth in section 67.5116 for collocation of
9 small wireless facilities on authority poles shall remain
10 effective for the duration of the permit authorizing the
11 collocation."; and

12 Further amend said bill, page 12, section 393.1015, line 18
13 by inserting after all of said line the following:

14 "620.2459. Pursuant to section 23.253 of the Missouri
15 sunset act:

16 (1) The provisions of the [new] program authorized under
17 sections 620.2450, 620.2451, 620.2452, 620.2453, 620.2454,
18 620.2455, 620.2456, 620.2457, and 620.2458 shall sunset
19 [automatically three years after August 28, 2018] on June 30,
20 2027, unless reauthorized by an act of the general assembly; and

21 (2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized

2 by striking all of said lines and inserting in lieu thereof the
3 following:

4 "12. Any gas corporation whose ISRS is found by a court of
5 competent jurisdiction to include unlawful and inappropriate
6 charges shall refund every current customer of the gas
7 corporation who paid such charges, before the gas corporation can
8 file for a new ISRS."
