ASSUMPTION

§431.061 - Parental consent for vaccinations

Officials from the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Public Safety, Missouri State Highway Patrol, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of State Courts Administrator, the Adair County Health Department and the Columbia/Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these organizations.

Officials from the Cooper County Public Health Center assume unknown revenues and savings due to the prevention of disease as well as unknown costs and potential losses.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary but assumes the Cooper County Public Health Center's unknown revenues/savings and unknown costs/losses will be minimal and absorbable within current funding levels.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other Local Public Health Agencies were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
