FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§210.115 - Child abuse and neglect, unaccompanied minor

Oversight notes the Department of Corrections, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Social Services and the Columbia/Boone County Public Health and Human Services have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these organizations.

Officials from the **Cooper County Public Health Center** assumed unknown revenues, savings, costs and losses. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. However, based on other responses, Oversight assumes Cooper County Public Health Center's fiscal impact will be minimal and absorbable within current resources.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, hospitals, other local public health agencies and schools were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
