FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§§419.020 and 419.040 - Room rates and safe deposit boxes in lodging establishments

Oversight notes the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Office of State Courts Administrator and the Cooper County Public Health Center have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these organizations.

Oversight reviewed information from the Office of State Courts Administrator on penalties collected in FY 2019 and determined that no fines were collected under penalty code 419.050 which provides that any hotel keeper that charges a guest a greater rate than is specified on the notice shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, is to be fined a fee of not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each offense.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other Local Public Health Agencies were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
