§21.750 - Firearms

Oversight notes the Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol, the Department of Transportation, the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, the Office of Administration, the Office of State Courts Administrator, the State Public Defender's Office, the City of Kansas City, Perry County, the St. Louis County Police Department, the St. Louis County Department of Justice Services, the Joplin Police Department, and the Springfield Police Department have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, counties, police and sheriff's departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
