FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§§578.012, 578.015, 578.017, and 578.021 - Animal abuse

Oversight notes the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol, the Department of Social Services, the Department of Agriculture, the Office of State Courts Administrator, the State Public Defender's Office, the Boone County Sheriff's Department, the Springfield Police Department, the Joplin Police Department, the St. Louis County Police Department, and the St. Louis County Department of Justice Services have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **Missouri Office of Prosecution Services (MOPS)** assume the proposal will have no measurable fiscal impact on MOPS. The creation of a new crime creates additional responsibilities for county prosecutors which may, in turn, result in additional costs, which are difficult to determine.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other police and sheriff's departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.

Oversight will assume that any psychological or psychiatric evaluation and/or treatment will be paid for by the convicted person (or their parent, guardian, or other person having care of the child) and will not result in a fiscal impact to the state.
