## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

#### §575.180 - Failing to execute an arrest warrant

**Oversight** notes the **Department of Revenue**, the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol**, the **Office of State Courts Administrator**, the **Joplin Police Department**, the **Springfield Police Department**, the **St. Louis County Police Department**, and the **St. Louis County Department of Justice Services** have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

#### House Amendment (HA) 1 and HA 1 to HA 1:

Officials from the **Department of Revenue**, the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol**, and the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the amendment will not change the estimated fiscal impact to their department.

Oversight has no information to the contrary, therefore, **Oversight** assumes HA 1, as amended, has no additional fiscal impact.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other police and sheriff's departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
