FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the Columbia/Boone County Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) assume an unknown cost from this proposal. PHHS will be involved in some of the inspections resulting from this bill and is unclear on how many facilities will require inspections.

Oversight notes the proposal is permissive in nature and would not have a local fiscal impact without the action of the county commissioners of Boone County to adopt rules, regulations or ordinances on rented residences. Oversight notes should the commission take action on this proposal, penalties and civil fines could be assessed in the rules. Oversight assumes some of the fine revenue could offset the some of the costs of inspections that could be done. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a fiscal impact that will net to \$0 (no maintenance code adopted by Boone County Commission) to (Unknown) cost since the cost of maintenance and repairs may be more than the fine revenue.

Officials at the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Department of Public Safety's Office of the Director, the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Health and Senior Services and the Office of Prosecution Services each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

In response to a previous version, officials at the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations** assumed no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight notes the Department of Public Safety's Office of the Director, the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Health and Senior Services and the Office of Prosecution Services have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for these agencies.
