ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Department of Public Safety, Office of the State Courts Administrator, Springfield Police Department, St. Louis County Department of Justice Services, and St. Louis County Police Department** assume this proposal has no fiscal impact.

Because of the consistent response and lack of conflicting information, **Oversight** shows a \$0 direct fiscal impact to state government and local political subdivisions.
