ASSUMPTION

§192.850 - Prioritization of public funding for family planning

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General (AGO)** assume any additional litigation costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing personnel and resources. However, the AGO may seek additional appropriations if there is a significant increase in litigation.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight assumes the AGO will be able to perform any additional duties required by this proposal with current staff and resources and will reflect no fiscal impact to the AGO for fiscal note purposes.

Officials from the **University of Missouri Health Care** state the proposed legislation, as written, should not create a negative fiscal impact.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect no fiscal impact to the University of Missouri Health Care for fiscal note purposes.

Oversight notes the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, the Office of State Courts
Administrator and the Columbia/Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these organizations.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local public health agencies and hospitals were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
