FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC)** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. However, if a significant number of entities were to begin reporting such activity as outlined in 130.047 RSMo, additional analysts would be required to assist in providing filing assistance and review of reports filed with the commission. Also, if the Commission identifies significant violations during the process established in Section 105.955.14 (2), (3), RSMo, or complaints received increase significantly an Investigator would be required to provide the proper oversight.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the St. Louis County Board of Elections, Platte County Board of Elections, Jackson County Election Board, and Kansas City Election Board each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the Missouri Ethics Commission, Office of the Secretary of State, St. Louis County Board of Elections, Platte County Board of Elections, Jackson County Election Board, and Kansas City Election Board have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local election authorities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
