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#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Transportation** and **Missouri Senate** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Office of the Governor** assume §226.040 grants the Governor the authority to appoint the chief executive officer with the title of director of the Department of Transportation. There should be no added costs to the Governor's Office as a result of this measure. However, if additional duties are placed on the office related to appointments in other TAFP legislation, there may be the need for additional staff resources in future years.

**Oversight** notes that the agencies mentioned above have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for these agencies.
