FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§196.298 - Cottage food sales over the internet

Officials from the **Cooper County Public Health Center** assume this proposal could fiscally impact their organization as a result of increased investigations. The fiscal impact is assumed to be unknown.

Oversight has no information to the contrary. Oversight assumes there could be an increase in investigations but also assumes any increase in the number of investigations would be minimal and, therefore, absorbable within current funding levels.

Officials from the **Adair County Health Department** responded to **Oversight's** fiscal note request but did not provide a statement of the fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes the proposal will not have a significant fiscal impact on the Adair County Health Department since they did not provide a statement of fiscal impact.

Oversight notes the **Department of Health and Senior Services** has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for this organization.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local public health agencies were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
