FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of the Secretary of State, Office of State Courts Administrator, and Department of Transportation each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Jackson County Election Board**, **St. Louis County Board of Elections**, and **Madison County Clerk** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes that the above agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Kansas City Election Board** assume the fiscal impact would be minimal, less than \$1,000 to reprint envelopes.

Oversight notes that Section 238.216.5 states that the circuit court shall mail the ballots and Section 238.216.9 states that any costs incurred by circuit court shall be paid by the petitioners. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero fiscal impact to local election authorities on the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local election authorities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
