FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue** and **Missouri Ethics Commission** both assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight notes that Section 115.306.2 (4) states that this subdivision shall only apply to a city not within a county's offices that perform county functions (City of St. Louis). Oversight assumes that any costs arising as a result of this proposal can be absorbed by City of St. Louis with current resources; therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local election authorities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
