Officials from the Department of Agriculture, State Tax Commission, Department of Natural Resources, Missouri Lottery Commission, Department of Public Safety (Missouri State Emergency Management Agency, Alcohol and Tobacco Control, Division of Fire Safety, Missouri National Guard, Office of the Director & the Missouri Highway Patrol), Department of Higher Education & Workforce Development, Missouri Gaming Commission, Legislative Research Division, Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, Department of Commerce and Insurance, Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, Missouri Senate, Office of the Attorney General, MoDOT & Patrol Employees' Retirement System, the Department of Social Services, the Office of the State Auditor, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Office of Administration, the Department of Economic Development, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Office of the State Public Defender, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Department of Mental Health, Department of Transportation, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Office of the State Treasurer, Missouri State Employee Retirement System and the Department of Health and **Senior Services** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.
