FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at **St. Louis City** state the Fiscal Manager of the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department assumes no measurable fiscal impact from the passage of this legislation. §285.040 of the proposed legislation would remove the residency requirement for all City of St. Louis employees. The City's Department of Personnel stated that the fiscal impact of this bill cannot be determined.

Oversight notes §71.201 from HCS for HB 1604 has been removed in this version of the proposal. Therefore, this proposal will affect municipal police forces within the City of St. Louis. Oversight notes §285.040 removes the residency requirement for all employees of the City of St. Louis. Oversight assumes this section of the proposal could have a potential <u>indirect</u> impact on the City of St. Louis; however, Oversight will reflect no <u>direct</u> fiscal impact for this proposal.
