# **ASSUMPTION**

§311.293 - Permitted hours of sale of intoxicating liquor

Oversight notes the Department of Revenue, the Department of Public Safety - Alcohol and Tobacco Control, and the City of Kansas City have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **City of Brentwood** responded to the legislation but did not provide a fiscal impact.

Officials from the **City of Springfield** state there is a potential positive fiscal impact to the City of Springfield. However, the impact in unquantifiable without knowing how the proposed legislation will affect the City's general fund.

**Oversight** assumes any potential impact on cities and counties would be indirect. Therefore, for purposes of this fiscal note, Oversight will present a zero impact to local governments.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities and counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
