#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials at the **Department of Public Safety's Division of Fire Safety** assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **City of Kansas City** and the **City of Springfield** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective entities from this proposal.

**Oversight** notes the Department of Public Safety's Division of Fire Safety, the City of Kansas City and the City of Springfield have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight notes a potential savings could occur to municipalities that have their own fire-fighting service by not responding to calls for the newly annexed area that is within a fire protection district. Oversight also notes that fire protection districts could continue to answer calls for newly annexed areas. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a \$0 fiscal impact for this proposal.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities and fire protection districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation, but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
