ASSUMPTION

§§197.305 and 197.318 - Nursing facility occupancy rates

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS)** state the Division of Regulation and Licensure (DRL) currently processes Certificate of Need applications. The proposed legislation will require staff to review additional information; however, this will not create a significant change to time spent on the application process and is within the normal ebb and flow of work scope for DRL, so minimal time and expense will be required to conduct the requirements of the proposed legislation.

The DHSS anticipates being able to absorb these costs. However, until the FY21 budget is final, the department cannot identify specific funding source.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect no fiscal impact for the DHSS for fiscal note purposes.
