FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Kansas City Election Board, Platte County Board of Elections, Jackson County Election Board, and St. Louis County Board of Elections** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes according to the NCSL, as of to date, 16 states and the District of Columbia (for a combined total of 196 electoral votes) have passed National Popular Vote bills into law. Oversight assumes that the Secretary of State is responsible for certifying presidential electors and the local election authorities have the resources in order to comply with this proposal. Therefore, Oversight will zero fiscal impact on this note.

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.

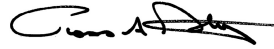
This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
