# **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Conservation (MDC)** assume this proposal will have an unknown negative fiscal impact caused by conflicting language between this proposal and the Wildlife Code of Missouri.

**Oversight** notes according to MDC's website, MDC seeks input from the public in regards to changes to the Missouri Wildlife Code on an annual basis. From this input, recommendations are provided to the Director and the Conservation Commission. Oversight assumes there will not be a direct fiscal impact. Fiscal impact will be determined after MDC seeks input from the public in regards to changes to the Missouri Wildlife Code.

Officials from the **Department of Agriculture (MDA)** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

**Oversight** notes that MDA has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for MDA.
