ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance** (**Public Service Commission** and the **Office of Public Counsel**), the **Department of Natural Resources**, the **Attorney General's Office** and the **Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.
