FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Missouri House of Representatives, Department of Public Safety - Office of the Director and the Department of Social Services each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state the proposal would have insignificant costs on their department.

Officials from the **Office of the State Public Defender (SPD)** assume no direct fiscal impact from the proposal. However, the results of the Committee's study could have an impact on the SPD.

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** state there may be some impact, but there is no way to quantify that currently. Any significant changes will be reflected in future budget requests by the administrator of the fund.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have each stated the proposal would not have a material direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **Missouri Senate (SEN)** anticipate a negative fiscal impact to reimburse travel for 2 Senators to attend task force meetings. The SEN assumes an average of 265 miles (round trip) x \$0.43 per mile x 2 Senators = \$227.90 per meeting.

Assuming the same level of reimbursement for all twenty members of the task force and assuming quarterly meetings, **Oversight** assumes mileage reimbursement to be roughly \$9,100 per year (265 miles x \$0.43 x 20 members x 4 meetings). Oversight assumes this amount could be absorbed within existing appropriation levels and will not reflect a fiscal impact from this proposal.
