## **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance (Public Service Commission and Office of Public Counsel), the Department of Natural Resources, the Office of Administration, the Department of Transportation and the Missouri Department of Conservation each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
