ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Missouri Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Missouri Department of Economic Development, the Missouri Department of Revenue, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the Office of State Courts Administrator, the Office of Administration, the City of Springfield and the City of Kansas City have stated the proposed legislation would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations.
