FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Department of Natural Resources**, the **Department of Health and Senior Services** and the **State Tax Commission** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Oversight made several attempts to contact St. Louis County for a fiscal impact response regarding this proposal. Oversight notes this proposal requires St. Louis County to compile and keep a list of historic landfills in the county and make the list available to the public. This proposal also requires the County to establish procedures for any reclamation or remediation of a historic landfill and hold hearings before issuing land use permits. Oversight assumes this is a procedural and will not have a material fiscal impact on St. Louis County.
