AN ACT

To amend chapter 67, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to taxing districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 67, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 67.5200, to read as follows:

**67.5200. 1. For purposes of this section, the term "special taxing district" shall
2 include all taxing districts that impose any tax under the laws of this state; however,
3 "special taxing district" shall not include the state or federal government or the
4 government of any city or county in this state. "Special taxing districts" shall include, but
5 not be limited to, community improvement districts, transportation development districts,
6 tax increment financing districts, fire protection districts, ambulance districts, library
7 districts, port authority districts, and any other districts that impose a sales tax, property
8 tax, or other tax assessment within their borders and jurisdiction.**

**9 2. Every special taxing district in this state that is not otherwise required by statute
10 to have an audit performed by a certified public accountant or other qualified auditor, or
11 that does not have an audit performed in conjunction with the audit of its establishing or
12 approving city or county, shall have an audit performed annually by an independent
13 certified public accountant according to the provisions of this section.**

**14 3. Each special taxing district that is required to have an audit performed annually
15 by an independent certified public accountant according to the provisions of this section
16 shall individually select its own certified public accountant to perform such an audit,
17 through a fair and competitive bidding process that considers no less than three bids and
18 awards a contract to the lowest or best bidder. Contracts entered into under this**

19 subsection may have a duration of up to five years. Upon the termination of an existing
20 contract, a special taxing district shall hold a new fair and competitive bidding process to
21 award a subsequent contract.

22 4. Every certified public accountant performing an audit under this section shall
23 compile his or her findings into a report that shall be submitted to the special taxing
24 district that he or she audits.

25 5. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, special taxing districts
26 may use a portion of the revenue received under their taxing authority to pay the fees and
27 expenses arising under their contracts with certified public accountants to perform the
28 audits required under this section.

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
