### AN ACT

To amend chapter 557, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to criminal offenses.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 557, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 557.045, to read as follows:

**557.045. No person found guilty of, or pleading guilty to, the following offenses**  
2 **shall be eligible for probation, suspended imposition or execution of sentence, or**  
3 **conditional release, and shall be sentenced to a term of imprisonment pursuant to**  
4 **subdivision (1) of subsection 2 of section 557.011:**

5       **(1) Second degree murder, as defined in section 565.021;**

6       **(2) Any dangerous felony, as the term is defined in section 556.061, where the**  
7 **person has been previously found guilty of a class A or B felony or a dangerous felony; or**

8       **(3) Any dangerous felony, as the term is defined in section 556.061, where the**  
9 **commission of the felony involves the use of a deadly weapon, as that term is defined in**  
10 **section 556.061.**
