2	WHEREAS, the state of Missouri and the Republic of China (Taiwan) entered into a sister-state relationship in 1980; and

4 5	WHEREAS, Missouri and Taiwan share the values of freedom, democracy, rule of law and respect for human rights; and

7 8 9	WHEREAS, Taiwan held its seventh direct election for president on January 11, 2020 which demonstrates the strength and vitality of Taiwan's democracy and exemplifies Taiwan's role as a beacon of democracy in Asia; and

11	WHEREAS, Missouri and Taiwan enjoy a mutually beneficial trade partnership; and

13 14	WHEREAS, Taiwan is Missouri's sixth-largest import partner and twenty-third-largest export partner; and

16 17 18	WHEREAS, negotiations for a fair and reciprocal bilateral trade agreement between Taiwan and the United States are an important step to further strengthen bilateral trade, which would increase Missouri exports; and

20 21 22 23	WHEREAS, April 10, 2019, marked the fortieth anniversary of the Taiwan Relations Act, 96 Pub. L. 8, which is a United States federal law that built a strong foundation for United States-Taiwan ties and that assures the continuation of commercial, cultural, and other relations between the two countries; and
