| 2 | WHEREAS , agriculture is the largest industry in Missouri, with an annual economic contribution of \$88 billion and employing nearly 400,000 people statewide; and |

| 4 5 6 7 | WHEREAS, according to the University of Missouri Extension Service, Missouri ranked third in beef cattle inventories as of 2017 and, according to the United State Department of Agriculture (USDA), was home to over 4.25 million head of cattle, including calves, in 2018; and |

| 9 10 11 | WHEREAS, in 2017, Missouri cattle and calves cash receipts indicated \$1.9 billion in value and Missouri earned an estimated \$207 million for its beef and veal exports, according to the USDA's Economic Research Service; and |

| 13 14 | WHEREAS, many farmers across the state rely on cattle and beef markets to provide an income to support their families and the families of those they employ; and |

| 16 17 18 | WHEREAS, the markets for both feeder and fed cattle and wholesale beef prices experienced severe reactions to the August 9, 2019, fire at the Tyson beef packing plant in Holcomb, Kansas; and |

| 20 21 | WHEREAS, prices for feeder and fed cattle plummeted and wholesale beef prices skyrocketed in the days following the fire; and |

WHEREAS, several organizations expressed concern about the ability for market manipulation. In an August 13, 2019, letter to the chair of the Commodity Futures Trading Commission, the National Cattlemen's Beef Association asked the commission to "keep an even closer eye on the cattle markets to ensure that no market participant tries to use the uncertainty to manipulate or illegally take advantage of the situation"; and

WHEREAS, USDA Secretary Sonny Perdue said in an August 28, 2019, statement that he has "directed USDA's Packers and Stockyards Division to launch an investigation into recent beef pricing margins to determine if there is any evidence of price manipulation, collusion, restrictions of competition or other unfair practices"; and

WHEREAS, the members of the General Assembly of this state are concerned about the effects of major packers dumping stocks on Missouri farmers and the entire economy of the United States:

38 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of 39 Representatives of the One Hundredth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate 40 concurring therein, hereby urge USDA Secretary Perdue to complete a full investigation into any 41 market manipulation following the fire at the Tyson beef packing plant and ensure swift 42 resolution and penalties for any parties found to have manipulated the market in order to gain 43 an unfair advantage at the expense of farmers, especially those in Missouri; and
