2	process for public colleges and universities to follow when seeking a statewide mission
3	designation; and

5	WHEREAS, a college or university must provide the Coordinating Board for Higher
6	Education with particular evidence of the institution's capacity to discharge a statewide
7	mission successfully; and

9	WHEREAS, Harris-Stowe State University provided the Coordinating Board with
10	the necessary evidence that it can successfully discharge a statewide mission in science,
11	technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) for underrepresented and underresourced
12	students; and

14	WHEREAS, the Coordinating Board voted to approve the request for such
15	designation on December 11, 2019:

19	Senate concurring therein, hereby approve of the statewide mission designation in STEM
