AN ACT

To amend chapter 209, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to persons with disabilities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 209, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 209.185, to read as follows:

2 **209.185. No entertainment venue shall discriminate against any person with a**
3 **disability, including persons who use a wheelchair or other mobility device. Ticket prices**
4 **for accessible seating shall not be higher than the price of other tickets in the same seating**
5 **section for the same event. Tickets for accessible seating shall be made available at all**
6 **price levels for every event. If tickets for accessible seating are not offered at a particular**
7 **price level because barrier removal in an existing facility is not readily achievable, the**
8 **percentage of tickets for accessible seating that should have been available at that price**
9 **level shall be offered for purchase, at that price level, in a nearby or similar accessible**
10 **location. The percentage is determined by the ratio of the total number of tickets at that**
price level to the total number of tickets for sale overall.
