HB 1366 -- SUNSHINE LAW

SPONSOR: Ellebracht

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Homeland Security by a vote of 7 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 7 to 0.

This bill modifies the law to allow records or meetings of governmental bodies that include descriptions of discussion about security procedures, including evacuation and lock down procedures, to remain confidential and closed to the public.

This bill is the same as HB 389 (2019).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this is simply an update to the Sunshine law to provide for current issues surrounding security.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Ellebracht.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
