

HB 1371 -- MISSOURI NATIONAL GUARD AND ACTIVE GUARD RESERVES

SPONSOR: Ellebracht

This bill expands the federal protections of the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (SCRA) and Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act (USERRA) to all members of the Missouri National Guard who are called to active duty by an executive order from the Governor and to all members of the Missouri Active Guard Reserves with 30 or more consecutive days of service.

Additionally, this bill requires the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations to make available a notice, which every employer will post in employment establishments, that covers certain employment rights, reemployment rights, and civil relief rights that apply to members of the Missouri National Guard.

This bill allows members of the Missouri Active Guard Reserves or Missouri National Guard who believes his or her rights were violated to bring suit in any court of competent jurisdiction and appropriate venue. The office of the Attorney General may also bring suit against an employer who violates the provisions of this bill.

This bill is the same as HB 514 (2019).
