

HB 1383 -- HEALTH AWARENESS DESIGNATIONS (Washington)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Special Committee on Tourism

This bill designates three time periods for health awareness.

The month of May is "Mental Health Awareness Month" and encourages citizens to participate in appropriate awareness and educational activities that emphasize the importance of good mental health and the effects of mental illness on Missourians.

This portion of the bill is the same as HB 108 (2019).

The month of July is "Minority Mental Health Awareness Month", and encourages citizens to observe the month with appropriate events and activities to raise awareness of the affects of mental illness on minorities.

This portion of the bill is the same as HB 171 (2019).

The month of September is "Deaf Awareness Month" and the last week of September as "Deaf Awareness Week". Citizens are encouraged to commemorate the First World Congress of the World Federation of the Deaf and increase awareness of deaf issues, people, and culture.

This portion of the bill is the same as HB 316 (2019).
