

HCS HB 1434 -- FINANCIAL INTEREST DISCLOSURE

SPONSOR: Richey

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Standing Committee on Elections and Elected Officials by a vote of 7 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Rules- Legislative Oversight by a vote of 10 to 0.

The following is a summary of the House Committee Substitute for HB 1434.

This bill allows the redaction of specified employment information concerning dependent children under 21 years of age who are related to persons required to file a financial interest form under Section 105.485, RSMo, upon request.

The following is a summary of the public testimony from the committee hearing. The testimony was based on the introduced version of the bill.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that information from this form was used to contact minor children of Representatives last year to add pressure on a vote of a controversial issue.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Richey.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.

OTHERS: There was no others testifying on the bill.
